Echocardiography

- 'Cardiac physiologist with training in congenital echo'
 - BUT no formal exam in Echo ACHD
- 4 of 5 BSE accredited team 'trained by experience'
- 1 trained ACHD and Paeds, new to UK, BSE 50%
- No PEC ... can use Paeds echo machine ... every cloud ..

Psychology

- 'experienced in care of paediatric cardiac patients'
- No but great local team who ask Q's and deliver

EoLC

'further in depth training': HF EolC Project ongoing

Torbay – IT – no change

- Images
 - Echos still not on PACS, no prospect
 - BUT good Radiology liaison, quick upload
- Database
 - Access DB, not up to date, idiosyncratic, out of date
 - No progress
- Connection to HeartSuite at BRI?
 - Dongle ?
 - No news
- Telemedicine/teleconference
 - In Paediatrics

Torbay – O&S - no change

- Learning Disabilities Liaison strong, effective
- Cardiac Rehabilitation strong, keen to help
