<u>Truro</u> – network team supporting UHB to identify additional sessions for backlog. Possibility of a new post with ACHD interest locally <u>Cheltenham</u> – overdue patients are being reviewed and wait is coming down

<u>Plymouth</u> – increase in local consultant. Waits have reduced from 242 patients at 59 weeks overdue to 156 patients at 29 weeks <u>Hywel Dda</u> – visit planned for 29/06 to understand pressures and actions

<u>Cwm Taf</u> – service has been unable to provide data. It is proving difficult to arrange a visit to understand what support can be offered

Hot spots

Bristol – Vacant posts and lack of outpatient capacity being addressed to bring waiting list down

<u>Torbay</u> – Additional sessions being done to clear backlog, but succession plans needed for consultant from Sep

<u>Hywel Dda</u> – HD has provided a risk score for this service to WHSSC to consider in their contract planning for specialised services. Additional sessions will be req from UHW





Surgical waits:

UHB paediatric surgical waiting list:

- Risk: Waiting list has come down slightly since peak and patients are being continually risk assessed and reprioritised. However, there is concern over the ability to get through enough activity over the summer to be in a good position heading into next winter when pressures on PIC and ward beds are likely to increase again. Constraints include ability to recruit sufficient specialist nurse to open all funded beds
