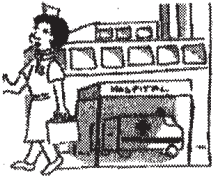
This leaflet tells you all about **LIAISE**.

Ask your doctor or nurse.



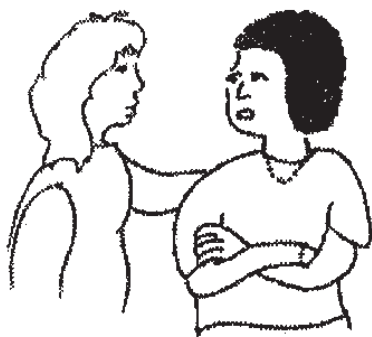
