CONGENITAL HEART DISEASE STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS NHS ENGLAND MAY 2016

- <u>ALL centres</u> in the Network (Section F of the standards) must:
- participate in audits of clinical practice where recognised standards exist or improvements can be made.
- Participation in a programme of ongoing audit of clinical practice must be documented.
- At least one audit of clinical practice (or more if required by NHS commissioners) of demonstrable clinical significance will be undertaken annually.
- Audits must take into account or link with similar audits across the network, other networks and other related specialties.

NETWORK AUDIT LEAD

Aims:

- To promote the importance of audit across the Network and to encourage the use of audit to help drive service quality improvement.
- To keep a record of ongoing audits for each Hospital/Health Board
- To facilitate the presentation of completed audits at the biannual CHD Network Clinical Governance meeting.

CURRENT PRACTICE

- Several audits completed in 2018 and already presented
- o I have only been made aware of 3 audits currently underway for 2019/20 across the Network:
- 1) Surgical waiting times and post op anticoagulant management '- Dr Stephanie Curtis
- 2) To assess the current standards/detection rate for fetal cardiac anomaly scanning (18-20+ week scan) in the South West region for TGA,ToF,HHS and cAVSD. Dr H Liversedge
- 3) Screening for liver disease in Fontan patients across South Wales- an audit of current practice. Dr Elliott Carande, Dr Szantho, Bethan Shiers, Sarah Finch, Dr Dirk Wilson, Dr Helen Wallis

LIMITATIONS TO UNDERTAKING AUDIT

- Dr Claire Williams (Cwm Taf HB)-' There is currently no funding to support audit/clinical governance or any other SPA-type activity in ACHD for the local satellite centres in Wales'.
- Dr David Lyndsay (Gloucestershire)- no current audits, actively seeking funding for an ACHD specialist nurse

- Enlist the help of a keen medical student or junior doctor who needs to undertake audits and supervise them.
- Combine resources and work across the Network to undertake audit.
