- Quality of living and dying – palliative care, respite care, hospices, and end of life care
- Supporting bereaved families

The aim of the workshop is to ease the journey that families and professionals make together.

In the second half of the day the Paediatric Palliative Care and Bereavement Support Team will be running a workshop on various aspects of care for families whose child may die (more information to follow).

The target audience for this study day is ‘multi-professional’ (nursing, medical, play, social work, chaplaincy, psychology and family support across BRHC)
